Welcome to y13 A Level English Literature. Please complete the following tasks over the Summer:

1. Continue drafting your coursework (NEA) essay. You should submit a full draft to ceri.boyle@nclt.ac.uk by the start of September. These will be saved centrally so that your teacher can review them before you restart lessons. You will have a NEA lesson every week up until October half term so that improvements can be made. Your final essay must be submitted by October half term.
2. You should read and summarise the information in the Keats' study guide. This will be emailed to you but is also on Moodle*. It is important that you have researched the context of this writer prior to studying the poems

3. It would be a good idea to pre-read the Keats poems in the anthology which will be provided before you go on y12 progression exam study leave. These will be studied in class so don't worry if you find them tricky at first.
