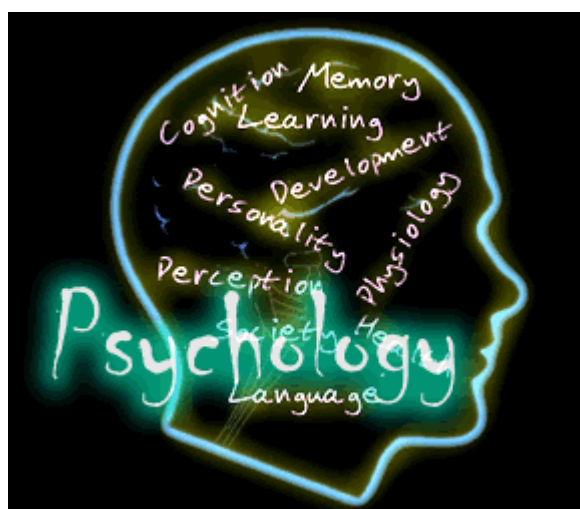

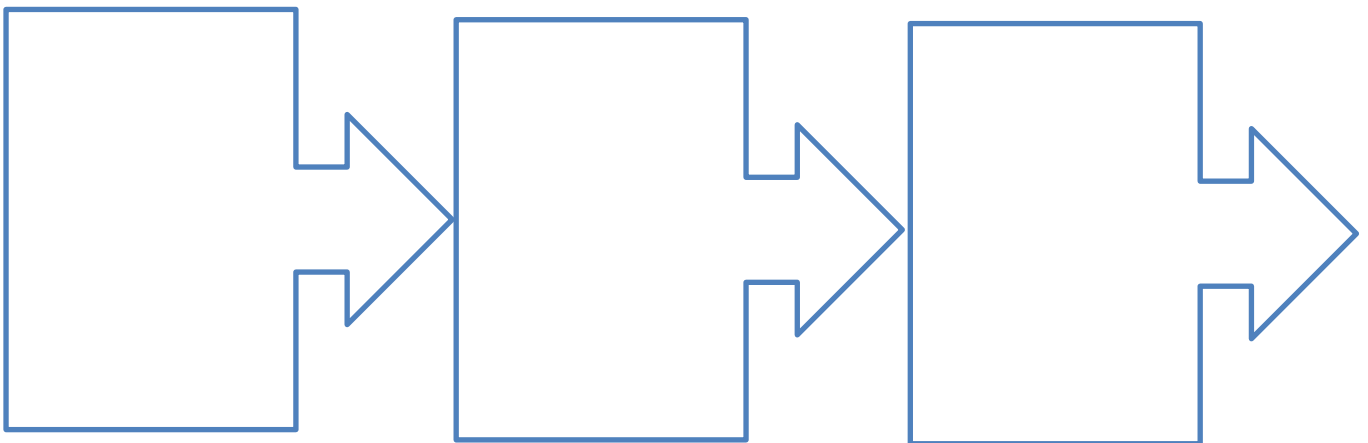

Label the diagram below for the information processing model:

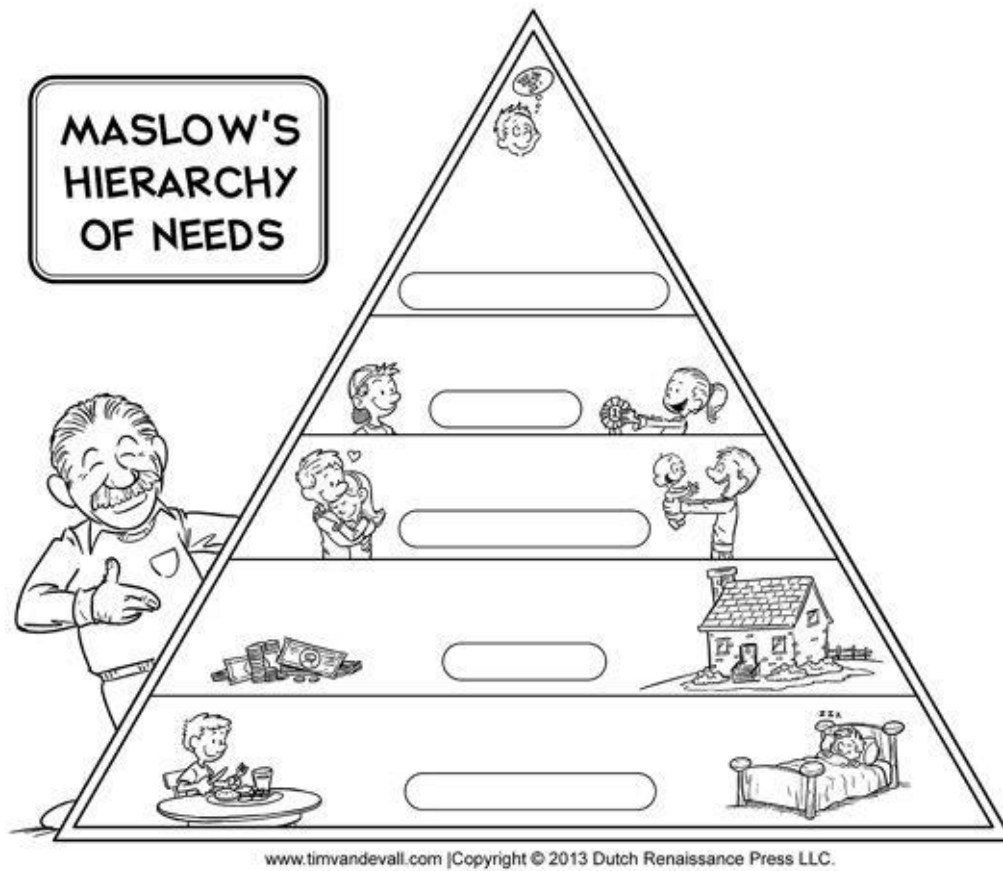


How might PTSD affect someone working in the Uniformed Protective Services?
