Mock Examinations and Results

The first series of mock examinations for this academic year has now been completed, and the results are available to view on Cedar. If you haven't created an account, please use the link below to do so. You will need a next of kin email address that we have on file and the student's reference number that starts with LOO. For students with access arrangements, please be reminded that these will remain the same for the January mocks and all external examinations throughout the year. The second mock series is scheduled to take place from **20**th – **27**th January **2025**, and students are encouraged to plan their preparation carefully, making use of the Christmas break to consolidate their learning.

Additionally, in line with guidance from JCQ, centres are required to collect evidence under exam conditions in case the summer exams are cancelled for any reason. Please note that results from the January mocks may be used to generate grades if required. These grades will only be valid for students who sit the mock exams alongside their cohort or as part of a supervised clash. Attendance at the January mocks is therefore of paramount importance, particularly as they represent the final opportunity for Year 13 students to experience authentic examination conditions before their summer exams.
