

Task 1 – Sustained Observational Artwork (4/5 hours)

Aim: Develop your technical skills in drawing and composition through a sustained study.

- → Choose **one** of the reference photographs provided showing strong **contrast**, **lighting**, and structure.
- → Create an A4 **monochrome study** in your strongest medium (e.g. graphite, charcoal, biro, pencil, etc.).
- → This artwork should be carefully observed, showing **refined tone**, **detail**, **and structure**.

Focus on proportion, texture, and tonal range.

Task 2 – Google Slides Set-Up

Set up a Google Slides presentation ready to document your work. If you do not have a personal Gmail account already, you will have to set one up to do this. Please use a format like <u>firstname.lastname.arts@gmail.com</u> when setting up your account. Slides is found on google drive and works in a similar way to PowerPoint and can be accessed from any type of device.

Once you have a google account and you are logged into google drive, create a new slides presentation:

+New (in top left)>google slides >blank presentation (and set up the slide size to match A3 paper by doing the following)

File>Page set up>custom>29.7cm x 42cm. Apply

In the top left corner, change the title from Untitled presentation to Your name and skills project. When you start college, you will then share this with your teacher.
