

## Important information about Exam Results Days - Summer 2026

Results Day for **A Level and Level 3 Applied/General Qualifications** is **Thursday 13 August 2026**.

You will be able to collect your results, in person, from college between 8.00am and 10.30am on that day.

If you are unable to come in to college to collect your results you have three other options available to you:

1. You can nominate someone else to collect your results on your behalf between 8.00am and 10.30am on Thursday 13 August 2026. The person collecting would need to bring a letter signed by you stating the name of the person collecting them, and that you give your permission for them to collect – in the letter you must also state your full legal name and date of birth. The person nominated to collect must bring some form of photographic ID of themselves to show to staff before they are given the results.
2. You can provide an A4 sized stamped addressed envelope to the Exams Officer before Friday 10 July 2026 and your results will be put in the post to you on Thursday 13 August 2026. Please ensure you put the correct amount of postage on the envelope (Large Letter stamp).
3. You can view your results on Cedar from 8am on Friday 14 August 2026.

Some staff will be available on Thursday 13 August should you need to discuss your results.

If your results were not what you expected and this may affect your next steps, don't worry, the careers team will be available on the day to speak to. There will also be a number of local universities in attendance offering clearing places and Wakefield Employment Hub to support you if you are looking for employment or an apprenticeship. We will be based in the LRC during the morning, and the careers team can keep in touch with you after results day if you need further support.

### Post Results Services

After every results day. All awarding bodies offer a number of different Post-results Services.

If you have a University place pending, you can request a priority review of marking and a priority copy of marked papers.

If you do not have a University place pending, you can request a priority copy of marked papers, a clerical re-check or a review of marking.

There is no grade protection for review of marking. This means that your marks and subject grades may be lowered, confirmed or raised as a result of the review.

Please note that a review of marking is **NOT a remark** of your paper, it is a process that is carried out to make sure the agreed mark scheme has been applied correctly, and includes a clerical check.

Further details of how to apply for any of the Post Results Services, the associated costs and deadlines for requests will be provided to you with your results on 13 August.
