

SIL (Summer Independent Learning) Year 12-13 2026

Your Summer Independent Learning leading into year 13 will be a couple of tasks which will help you prepare for a Practice Pitch which you will be presenting in the first few weeks of term in September. This practice pitch is with a view to preparing you for your formal B2 Pitch, which will directly go towards your AC4 and AC5 grades for your B2. See this as a dry run.

The work that you will be doing over summer will be based on the game concept that you based your A2 assignment on (Contrast brief).

The work will be split into two tasks, as outlined below, but you can find further guidance in our [Teams page](#):

Task One

Using the concept that you based your A2 assignment production on, you need to write an extended written proposal which presents your game concept.

This will be written in a formal manner in a Word Document, and will contain an overview of your concept, some prototype material, technical considerations, legal considerations and ethical considerations.

Task Two

Again, using the same concept from A2, you need to produce a One Pager which should quickly and visually communicate your game concept on a single, visually engaging page.

This can be produced using Photoshop or PowerPoint and will help communicate the gameplay and mechanics of your game, the theme and overall tone of your game.
